Tournament Rules

- Tournament will be carried out according to the rules of Badminton Scotland including the prohibition of doping which may be carried out.
- Feather shuttlecocks will be used. The tournament will be played in pools. Format based on entry size:
 - Pool games format will be determined based on entry size
 - There will be a consolation plate for all events
 - Knockout A & B will be will be best of 3 games to 21 with setting.
 - Round Robin may be played in an event if there is a small entry (no consolation plate)
- The committee reserves the right to make any changes necessary to facilitate the smooth running of the tournament
- Players absent when called upon to play may be scratched.
- Players should inform the desk if they leave the hall or are unable to play.
- A separate entry form must be used by each player and no player will be accepted for a Doubles Event unless Entry Forms have been received from each player. If you require a partner then the organiser will match up where possible; if there is no available partner refunds will be given on day.
- Late entries may only be accepted at the discretion of the Tournament organiser
- Players must advise the Referee on arrival at the Championships if they do not wish to be included in official photographs which may be taken by the tournament organisers.
- Neither the Highland Badminton Group, nor Fortrose Academy (Black Isle Leisure Centre) will be under any liability in respect of any personal loss or injury. Competitors are responsible for arranging cover if required.
- They should be accompanied by the appropriate entry fees and should arrive no later than closing date stated above.

Please inform the tournament organiser of any withdrawals – contact details above.
If using mobile no. on the day of tournament it would be better to text.

Parental Code of Conduct for Tournaments

Any player entered in a tournament (domestic or otherwise) is expected to show a responsible attitude in both performance and appearance: this includes arriving in a fit state to participate and behaving appropriately both during and between matches.

Parents/guardians play a vital role in the development of the player. We ask that you adhere to this Parental Code of Conduct.

All parents/guardians are asked to adhere to the undernoted:

1. to ensure, whenever possible, that your child arrives at all tournaments timeously (and at least 20 minutes before scheduled tournament matches);
2. to show respect to fellow parents/guardians; and to demonstrate appropriate social
3. behaviour;
4. never to speak negatively to, or about, other players, in front of your own child or anyone else; to show respect to all coaches and tournament volunteers;
5. to show respect to the decisions of the court officials;
6. to note that you may watch matches, but are asked not to communicate with your child during such matches, except where coaching is allowed at breaks;
7. to ensure you child is well behaved on and off court;
8. to treat all other players and parents/guardians with respect: without your children's opponents, there would be no matches!;
9. to ensure that your child is collected safely at the end of tournaments, or that they have permission to travel home by other means.

Finally, please note that any instances of poor conduct on the part of any parent/guardian, or breaches of this Code, may result in action being taken against the parent/guardian in question in the form of a ban from attending future tournaments, for a determined period of time.
