1. *The tournament will be conducted under the rules of the Badminton World Federation and to the tournament regulations of the Scottish Badminton Union, including the prohibition of doping for which tests may be carried out.*
2. *All matches in the main event will be the best of three games to 21 using the rally point scoring system.*
3. *Intervals not exceeding 60 seconds during each game when the leading score reaches 11 points and 120 seconds between the first and second game and between the second and third game where appropriate shall be allowed in all matches.*
4. *Subject to entry and court-time available, there will be a consolation event for all first tie losers in both singles and level doubles.*
5. *If in any event the entry is low, the event will be played as a round robin.*
6. *Players absent when called on to play will be scratched.*
7. *Each player must use a separate entry form.*
8. *No pair shall be accepted for a doubles event unless entry forms have been received from both players.*
9. *The Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry without giving their reasons*
10. *Late entries can only be accepted at the discretion of the Tournament Director. In line with Badminton Scotland's policy a financial penalty of £5.00 per event may be imposed for late entries.*
11. *No entry will be accepted for any player who has taken part in any unauthorised Tournament, League or Match.*

15. *The Committee reserves the right to add or alter these conditions. Its decision will in all matters be final.*

17. *No start times will be issued by post (see condition 19). Your **first start time will be emailed** to those competitors who complete their email address clearly.*
18. *Any player wishing a written time slip giving the time of their first game or a receipt for entry fees must enclose a **STAMPED ADDRESSED ENVELOPE** with the entry form.*
19. *Any player withdrawing from the tournament unannounced shall have his or her name sent to Badminton Scotland who may take appropriate action.*
20. *Players must advise the Referee on arrival at the Championships if they do not wish to be included in photographs which may be taken over the course of the Championships.*
